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STREETS ARE FOR EVERYONE

On 20 September 2026, we will meet at 2 p.m. at the Skatepark in Neustadt and set off at 3 p.m. to cycle through Halle under the motto "Streets are for everyone."

We demand:

- Safe routes to schools
- Finally make Kleine Ulrichstraße genuinely car-free!
- Steinweg: Convert car parking spaces into cycle paths
- Car parking spaces for everyone – to be used as parking facilities for bicycles, scooters, prams and walking frames
- Safe road markings for improved cycle paths and protected cycle lanes
- No further land sealing: instead, open up spaces and make them greener!
- In the spirit of solidarity: increase parking fees

Kidical Mass is a worldwide alliance campaigning for greater safety for children in road traffic. During the campaign weeks, people around the world take to the streets to call for a fairer distribution of public space and for child-friendly, environmentally sustainable mobility. We want everyone to be able to get around safely on foot, by bicycle, in a wheelchair or with a pram. To achieve this, streets must be accessible to everyone and viable alternatives to the car must be provided. Only in this way can we successfully transform the way we travel. This requires voices and bicycle bells!

The journey to daycare and school must be safe. In Halle, a considerable amount of public road space is occupied by cars – by traffic lanes and parked vehicles, including on pavements and at junctions and intersections. Cars, trams, buses and bicycles

often have to share the same lanes, which can lead to dangerous situations. When overtaking, the minimum distance of 1.5 metres is too often disregarded. This must change to ensure safe mobility.
